Cell Phone and Electronics Policy

Cell Phones are not allowed during class. When entering your classroom all electronic devices must be placed in the classroom caddy. Phones are a distraction to the learning process. If you do not put your phone in the caddy, it will be collected by the teacher and held till the end of the day. After the third time, a parent must pick up the phone in the office the following day. If a student refuses to turn over their cell phone, an immediate suspension will be issued.

Earbuds/Headphones are not allowed at any time during the school day. This is a safety issue. Too often students do not hear or respond to teachers when they are called. In case of an emergency, students must be able to hear potentially lifesaving instructions. Earbuds/Headphones must be kept in bookbags all day. If you do not keep your Earbuds/Headphones in your bookbag or home, it will be collected by the teacher and held till the end of the day. After the third time, a parent must pick up the item in the office the following day. If a student refuses to turn over their Earbud/Headphone, an immediate suspension will be issued.
