CONDUCT

Graduation is the largest academic event held in the community each year. Graduation is a **DIGNIFIED** ceremony that will leave a lasting impression on all who attend. Exemplary behavior and flawless execution of the ceremony are essential. The ceremony is to honor an entire class of graduates. **An individual does not have the right to ruin the ceremony for everyone else**. All school rules will be enforced including the school dress code and the dress described above. During the ceremony, you should remain alert, quiet, and courteous at all times. Remind guests that they too should be quiet and only applaud at the appropriate time. Rude, unruly, or disruptive behavior will necessitate removal by security personnel.

AFTER GRADUATION:

Students MUST return the graduation gowns before leaving the NFCC Campus. We will have a area at Van H. Priest, where students can check them back in. After turning in graduation gowns, students will then receive their personalized diploma

Things to Remember concerning Graduation:

- All practices for graduation are **MANDATORY!** You must attend all practices and remain until dismissed in order to participate in the ceremony Saturday morning, May 26, 2018 at 10:00 a.m..
- All disciplinary (detentions and /or suspensions) and financial obligations must be cleared before participating in graduation. This includes, but is not limited to, lunch order(s), returning textbooks, and class dues.
- Graduation: May 26th 10:00 A. M. Van H. Priest Auditorium NFCC, you MUST BE THERE 1 HOUR EARLY.
- NOTICE: Graduating Seniors need to be at each practice and event on time or they will NOT BE ALLOWED TO WALK on Graduation day.
