F.S.S. 836.10 Written threats to kill or do great bodily injury, or conduct a mass shooting or an act of terrorism; punishment; exemption from liability.

- (1) A person who makes a threat in a writing or other record, including an electronic record, to kill or to do great bodily injury to another person and posts or transmits the threat in any manner that would allow another person to view the threat, commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, 38 s. 775.083, or s. 775.084
- (2) This section does not impose liability on a provider of an interactive computer service, communications services as defined in s. 202.11, a commercial mobile service, or an information service, including, but not limited to, an Internet service provider or a hosting service provider, if it provides the transmission, storage, or caching of electronic communications or messages of others or provides another related telecommunications, commercial mobile radio service, or information service for use by another person who violates this section. This exemption from liability is consistent with and in addition to any liability exemption provided under 47 U.S.C. s. 50 230.
