

JMPHS Senior Fees 2018-19

At JMPHS we know that one of the greatest experiences in life is the senior year of high school. Twelve years of hard work and preparation culminate in a final year full of bittersweet reflection on the past and exciting anticipation of the future. Because of the magnitude of the senior year experience, we strive to make sure it is the best we can make it for our students.

To cover the cost of student-specific graduation expenses, such as cap and gown, diploma and cover, and other Baccalaureate and Graduation fees, senior fees are \$50. The school uses these fees to ensure all students receive the identical and correct items used for Baccalaureate and Graduation. All JMPHS seniors planning to participate in Baccalaureate and Graduation **must** pay their senior fees. Failure to pay the senior fees will result in the student being unable to participate in these events unless he/she has extraordinary financial hardships, which are considered by the Administration on a case-by-case basis. These fees only affect Baccalaureate and Graduation and, thus, will not prevent a student from graduating or from participating in other school events such as prom or Grad Bash.

Senior fees are **non-refundable**. Any seniors who do not fulfill the state-mandated graduation requirements, who transfer schools, or who choose not to participate in Baccalaureate and Graduation will not be refunded any portion of the senior fees as these fees cover class-wide events. The gowns students receive for the Baccalaureate and Graduation ceremonies are rented. Therefore, the gown will be returned after Graduation, but students may keep the caps. Failure to return the gown will result in the full cost of the gown being paid by the student and his/her diploma will be held until the balance is paid.

Senior Fees are due by **Friday, August 17th** in order to secure the Baccalaureate and Graduation facilities and pre-order the caps and gowns. Students were given this information at Open House before the school year began and have been reminded daily in their classes. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact us at the school.
